2021 K-12 FITTED FOR SUCCESS PROGRAM INFORMATION AND CHECKLIST

Wood County DJFS is helping with **backpacks, basic school supplies, hygiene items, shoes and to children** who will be attending kindergarten through 12th grade during the 2021-2022 school year. If available, coats may also be provided.

Enclosed are the application materials and a checklist of needed verifications. Applications will be accepted until 500 children are approved.

Each eligible child in the assistance group will receive one backpack filled with grade appropriate supplies. The supplies will be general supplies and will not include all the supplies or the exact supplies that your child's school may be requesting. Each child will also receive one voucher which will be good for the purchase of shoes and socks. For grades K-3, a \$75 voucher will be issued. For grades 4-12, a \$100 voucher will be issued. Each voucher will only be good at the approved store.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) An adult (18 years or older) must apply. That adult must be the caretaker for the child(ren) and live in the same home.
- 2) The school-age child(ren) must be a U.S. citizen or meet qualified alien status requirements.
- 3) Your total family income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines of gross monthly income (see below).

Checklist of Verifications:

You must submit all applicable verifications. **Do not send originals.** Your application may be denied if any of these verifications are missing or not legible. If any of these verifications are already on file and current, you will not need to resubmit those verifications.

If you are unsure if any of the verifications are on file or are unsure how to obtain them, please contact the agency at **419-376-3488**.

Your application will be **processed within 30 calendar days of receipt** of your signed application. If you are approved, an approval letter will be mailed to you. **Pick-up dates and instructions will be listed on the letter sent to you.**

Copies of Birth Certificates or Hospital Records or other Citizenship Verification AND Copies of Social Security Cards

- Required for you, your spouse or partner with whom you have children or stepchildren and all minor children in the household.

Verification of all Earned and Unearned Income

- Required for both you and/or your spouse/partner if employed or have just started employment. Acceptable verifications include last 4 weeks of pay stubs for current employment, self-employment records, employer verification statements for new employment, etc.
- Required for you, your spouse/partner and your minor children if any are receiving income. Types of unearned income include child support, Social Security, Workman's Comp., Unemployment Comp., VA benefits, retirement benefits, etc.

I received a complete explanation regarding the requirements for determining eligibility, the reasons why I may not be eligible, my responsibility for reporting changes to the Wood County Department of Job and Family Services and the penalty, including possible civil action or criminal prosecution, for the intentional withholding or falsification of information.

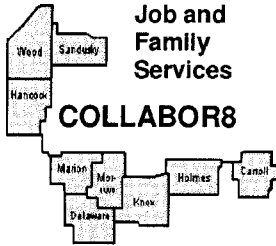

Voter Registration and Information Update Form

Please read instructions carefully. Please type or print clearly with blue or black ink.

Eligibility

You are qualified to register to vote in Ohio if you meet all the following requirements:

1. You are a citizen of the United States.
2. You will be at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election.
3. You will be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before the election in which you want to vote.
4. You are not incarcerated (in jail or in prison) for a felony conviction.
5. You have not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court.
6. You have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of election laws.

Use this form to register to vote or to update your current Ohio registration if you have changed your address or name.

NOTICE: This form must be received or postmarked by the 30th day before an election at which you intend to vote. You will be notified by your county board of elections of the location where you vote. If you do not receive a notice following timely submission of this form, please contact your county board of elections.

Numbers 1 and 2 below are required by law. You must answer both of the questions for your registration to be processed.

Registering in Person

If you have a current valid Ohio driver's license, you must provide that number on line 10. If you do not have an Ohio driver's license, you must provide the last four digits of your Social Security number on line 10. If you have neither, please write "None."

Please see information on back of this form to learn how to obtain an absentee ballot.

Registering by Mail

If you register by mail and do not provide either an Ohio driver's license number or the last four digits of your Social Security number, you must enclose with your application a copy of one of the following forms of identification:

Current and valid photo identification, a military identification, or a current (within the last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document (other than a notice of voter registration mailed by a board of elections) that shows the voter's name and current address.

Residency Requirements

Your voting residence is the location that you consider to be a permanent, not a temporary, residence. Your voting residence is the place in which your habitation is fixed and to which, whenever you are absent, you intend to return. If you do not have a fixed place of habitation, but you are a consistent or regular inhabitant of a shelter or other location to which you intend to return, you may use that shelter or other location as your residence for purposes of registering to vote. If you have questions about your specific residency circumstances, you may contact your local board of elections for further information.

HOW TO OBTAIN AN OHIO ABSENTEE BALLOT

You are entitled to vote by absentee ballot in Ohio without providing a reason. Absentee ballot applications may be obtained from your county board of elections or from the Secretary of State at: www.OhioSecretaryofState.gov or by calling (877) 767-6446.

OHIO VOTER IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Voters must bring identification to the polls in order to verify identity. Identification may include current and valid photo identification, a military identification, or a copy of a current (within the last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document (other than a notice of voter registration mailed by a board of elections) that shows the voter's name and current address. Voters who do not provide one of these documents will still be able to vote by providing the last four digits of the voter's Social Security number and by casting a provisional ballot pursuant to R.C. 3505.181.
